'Comhtháthú Ábhar & Teanga: Cur Chuige Praiticiúil' – Sinéad Nic Stiofáin (IARBHUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Tá Sinéad Nic Stiofáin ag obair mar leas-phríomhoide i Scoil Chuimsitheach Chiaráin ar an gCeathrú Rua ó 2013. Roimhe sin, chónaigh agus d'oibrigh Sinéad i mBaile Átha Cliath agus bhí sí ina príomhoide tánaisteach i nGaelcholáiste Reachrann ó 2004-2012.

Tá taithí ag Sinéad ar an chúlra teanga a bhaineann leis an Gaelcholáiste agus an scoil Ghaeltachta agus tuiscint aici ar an dá chomhthéacs éagsúla seo. Tá sí sa dara bliain faoi láthair ar an chúrsa M.Oid i gColáiste Mhuire gan Smál agus í ag baint antairbhe as!

'Gaelscolaíocht den Scoth' – Gabriel Ó Cathasaigh – (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Tógadh Gabriel i Lios Póil. D'fhreastail sé ar Scoil Chluain Chumhra, Coláiste Bhréanainn, Cill Áirne, Coláiste Mhuire Gan Smál agus CIT.

Thosaigh sé amach ag múineadh sa Mhódhscoil i gCorcaigh 1981. Ceapadh mar phríomhoide é i nGaelscoil Uí Ríordáin 1983. Tá 781 dalta ag freastal ar an scoil i mbliana. Tógadh scoil álainn nua 2012 agus tá Gaeltacht bhreá acu anois i gCarraig an Earra i mBaile an Chollaigh.

Tá sé pósta le Bridie May agus tá triúr clainne acu - Micheál, Órla agus Caitríona.

'Ról an Chúntóir Ranga i gComhthéacs Mhodheolaíochta an Tumoideachais' – Thomas Rogan (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Is múinteoir é Thomas i nGaelscoil na bhFál. Tá taighde déanta aige le hOllscoil Ghlaschú ar ról na gcúntóirí ranga. Tabharfaidh an cheardlann seo deis do chleachtóirí athchuaire a thabhairt ar chur chuige forbairt an dara teanga sa suíomh tumoideachais agus ról an chúntóir ranga i sealbhú an dara teanga a fhiosrú. Beidh deis ag daoine dea-chleachtas ó thaobh ról an chúntóir ranga de a roinnt.

'Mathematical Strategies – An Overview' – Robert Thompson (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Robert works for the Education Authority's School Development Service as a School Improvement Professional. He supports schools in a range of school improvement issues and has a particular specialism in Numeracy. This workshop will provide an overview of 'Mathematical Strategies' including strategies for mental calculation and problem solving. Participants will have the opportunity to explore some practical tasks which will involve the use of these strategies based on 'tried and tested' classroom practice.

Question and Answer Session – Middletown Centre for Autism – Dr. Fiona McCaffrey (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT + IARBHUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Dr. Fiona McCaffrey is Head of Research and Development at Middletown Centre. Fiona has a graduate qualification in Autism; a Master's in Counselling and is a Chartered Psychologist with the British Psychological Society. She has worked individually and in group sessions with older children and young adults with autism and their parents. Fiona has spoken and presented nationally and internationally on autism and the work of Middletown Centre. Practitioners attending this workshop will have the opportunity to ask for advice on working with pupils with autism and come away with strategies to implement in the classroom.

'Straitéisí Praictíúla leis an Fheasacht Fóineolaíochta agus Scileanna Litearthachta a Fhorbairt' – Emily Barnes (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Oibríonn Emily sa tSaotharlann Foghraíochta agus Urlabhra i gColáiste na Tríonóide. Tá taigde ar siúl aici ar dheacrachtaí litearthachta sa Ghaeilge, agus ar an nasc idir an fheasacht fóineolaíochta agus an litearthacht sa Ghaeilge agus sa Bhéarla.

Díreofar ar an fheasacht fóineolaíochta agus an litearthacht sa cheardlann seo. Beidh plé ar straitéisí praiticiúla leis an fheasacht fóineolaíochta agus scileanna litearthachta a fhorbairt chomh maith le heolas ar na bealaí le deacrachtaí litearthachta a aithint i scoileanna lán-Ghaeilge.

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'Forbairt na Litearthachta i nGaeilge trasna an churaclaim agus soláthar sainriachtanais in earnáil na Gaelscolaíochta' – Mairéad Mhig Uaid (BUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Thosaigh Mairéad mar Chomhairleoir Oideachais san Áisaonad ag túis Mhí Iúil 2018. Roimhe sin, bhí sí ina Príomhoide, ina Leas-phríomhoide agus ina múinteoir i Scoil na Fuiseoige, i mBéal Feirste. Is mar gheall ar an tréimhse fhada ama a chaith sí ansin a bhfuil suim ar leith aici i bhforbairt foinní agus daltaí, mar aon le forbairt na Litearthachta i nGaeilge trasna an churaclaim agus soláthar sainriachtanais in earnáil na Gaelscolaíochta.

Inniu, pléifidh sí le féinchúram i gcomhthéacs eolas ar áiseanna. Pléifidh sí le háiseanna an Áisaonaid mar a leanas:

- iad a úsáid ar bhonn iomlán scoile,
- míreanna éagsúla oibre an Áisaonaid, go háirithe leis na háiseanna is úire
- an chéad chéim eile sa soláthar.

Matthew is the head of Equality and Diversity at the Education Authority. His team oversees a range of workplace initiatives that seeks to ensure that all EA staff can bring their whole selves to work, are enabled to be the best that they can be, that the workplace is reflective of the community it serves and that EA is considered an employer of choice.

Matthew started his career in the community and voluntary sector, working for a Human Rights charity before moving to the Health Service.

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'Mental Health and Trauma Awareness' – Ursula Mackel (IARBHUNSCOLAÍOCHT)

Ursula Mackel has been involved in post-primary education for over 20 years. Her background is in English and Literacy, which is, and will always remain, the whole school priority at St Colm's. She is passionate in her belief that every child has the right to be literate and that it is the responsibility of educators and facilitators to ensure that this happens. She has delivered training in both the primary and the post-primary sector in this area.

She is a member of the Senior Leadership Team in St Colm's High School and is the mental health lead as well as many other things! She is very interested in the effect of early childhood trauma and its manifestation in the school setting, and how educators can help these children and young people through their educational journey in the best way possible.

Áine-Máire Úí Néill

As Oileán an Ghuaile i gContae Thír Eoghain ó dhuchas d'Áine-Máire, Tá 20 bliain de thaithí aici ag teagasc in earnáil na Gaelscolaíochta. Creideann sí go daingean i bpriónsalabhl ña feinluachála le bheith ag síorfhéabhsú mar mhúinteoir. Is í an mhúinteoir chothaithe i Scoil an Droichid í, áit a ndéanann sí idirghabháil luath gearrthéarmach le páistí bun na scoile chomh

maith le tacaíocht a thabhairt do dhaltaí ag barr na scoile trí ghrúpaí sóisialta, grúpaí Lego agus grúpaí feabhas a reáchtáil. Scríobh sí ag leibhéal máistreachta (le gradam) ar phrionsabail agus ar éifeachtacht an chothaite san earnáil agus bronadh "Marjorie Boxall Quality Mark Award" ó Nurture UK ar a seomra ar na mallaibh. D'iarr an tÚdarás Oideachais uirthi oiliúint iomlán foirne a thabhairt i scoileanna eile agus ag comhdháil do cheannairí scoile maidir le dóigheanna éifeachtacha leis an chothú a chur i bhfeidhm.

Brónach Uí Mhórdha

Tá deich mbliana de thairthí ag Brónach bheith ag teagasc in earnáil na Gaelscolaíochta. Tá máistreacht i riachtanais speisialta aici agus suim mhór aici san ábhar seo. Mar sin, ghlac sí ról an SENCo i mbunscoil Bheann Mhadagáin in 2016. Chuir sí clár idirghabhála i bhfeidhm sa scoil ag tacú leis an mhúinteoir tacaíochta maidir le cursaí litearthachta. Mothaíonn sí go bhfuil nasc láidir de dhíth le tuismitheoirí agus go bhfuil siad croí lárnach i saol na scoile. Bíonn sí ag obair leo mar chuid den chlár 'Families Connect', ag tacú leo agus ag obair lena gcuid páistí maidir le forbairt phearsanta, shoisialta agus mhothúchánach, forbairt sa Litearthacht agus forabairt san Uimheartachta. Is múinteoir cothaite í i mbunscoil Bheann Mhadagáin. Tá suim an-láidir aici sa ról seo ag tabhairt tacaíochta do pháistí ag bun na scoile agus ag tacú le páistí ar fud na scoile ag glacadh grúpaí sóisialta agus grúpaí tacaíochta maidir le féin-mhuinín.

Sa ról seo bhí sí ábalta cur lena cuid taithí agus tuiscint ar an ábhar seo tríd traenáil in 'Lego Build to Express', 'Lego ABC' agus gníomhaíochtaí Theraplay a fhoghlaim agus a chur i feidhm. Tá nascanna cruthaithe aici le Supporting Families North Belfast, Save the Children, Barnardos, cnuasgrupaí den chothú, RSO, RISE NI, Behaviour Support, Harberton Outreach, Family Hub, scoileanna áitiúla fríd North Belfast Primary Principals Group.
